LAW PARK POND RESTOCKED

With the hot summer, lack of rain, and nutrient build up in Law Park Pond, the Village has undertaken to restock the pond with the addition of "Triploid Grass Carp". Many people have noticed the extensive and unwanted aquatic build up of vegetation commonly called "Duckweed". From a distance, the light green Duckweed appears to be algae; it is really a floating plant that thrives in warm, nutrient-rich, motionless water. The last time the Village stocked the pond was back in 2002, and since that time, the



fish population has not been able to keep up with the Duckweed bloom. Pictured in the release of the 10" fish are, left to right, Henry Jamin, Recreation Supervisor, Mark Silano, Park Groundskeeper and Joseph Silano, Part-Time Laborer. We hope that the addition of the carp, bred to be sterile, will enjoy the abundance of vegetation precluding the Village from having to treat the pond unnecessarily with chemicals. So we hope the fish eat well—But—please... NO FISHING!

WATER BILLING NEWS

The Village sends quarterly water bills to customers. Please pay attention to the due date as stated on each bill. After that time period has elapsed a 10% penalty is applied.

You may have your payment postmarked at the Post Office for the due date in order to avoid penalties.
