VILLAGE MANAGER'S REPORT (914) 944-2782

LONG HILL ROAD DRAINAGE PROJECT

The Village will begin a drainage project in April on Long Hill Road between Cottonwood Lane and Holly Place to improve roadside drainage. Traffic flow will be interrupted intermittently and will be kept to a minimum whenever possible. The project is expected to be concluded in May 2011.

CON EDISON SCARBOROUGH ROAD GAS MAIN PROJECT

To meet the area's increasing demand for gas service and improve reliability, Con Edison has undertaken a project to replace the old and install a new gas main on Scarborough Road between Holbrook Road and Lodge Road.

Their crews will work Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 3:00pm. They expect to start this project at the end of March and plan to complete it by early July 2011. Flag people will be there help ease traffic.

UNPAID WATER BILLS

Please be advised that all unpaid water bills, including fees and penalties (if any), will be transferred to your Village Tax bill in May 2011. Any amount due by April 30 and left unpaid by May 1 will be attached to your first installment of real estate tax due in June 2011.

A Village fee of \$50.00 will be attached to this transfer and these fees and penalties become taxes due. New York State law is very specific: We cannot adjust or refund funds for any reason.

Unpaid water bills accrue penalties and should be paid on a timely basis.

BASIC STAR PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION INCOME LIMIT

Beginning this year, legislation requires that taxpayers who earn more than \$500,000 will no longer receive the Basic STAR exemption. Please contact the Town Assessors (Ossining 762-8274 or Mt. Pleasant 742-2345) to review your eligibility or visit www.orps.state.ny.us for more information.
